Vivienne Sugar became Chair of the Welsh Consumer Council in April 2003, shortly after her retirement as Chief Executive of the City and County of Swansea, a post that she had held since 1995.

Vivienne now works as a Consultant to Government and Local Government. Between 2002 and 2004, she was also a member of the Richard Commission, which reviewed the powers and electoral arrangements of the National Assembly for Wales.

She is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Housing having previously been Director of Housing at both Cardiff and Newport. In 2005 she was appointed as Wales Advisor to the Joseph Rowntree Foundation and also became a Vice President of Swansea University.
